In her welcome speech, The President of The Buddhist Union, Venerable Bao Shi traced a short history of our founders, the late Venerable Dhammasukha and Venerable Dhammarakshita who later was known as Venerable Seck Kong Poh. She mentioned that under the guidance and advice of the two late Venerables, many activities had been organised from the Youth Section, to the study of the Dharma, the chanting of the sutras in both Pali and Chinese, meditation and Yoga.

Venerable Sek Bao Shi took over the leadership together with Venerable Sek Bao Tong when Venerable Seck Kong Poh passed on in 1986. Both the



Venerables took their Higher Triple Ordination in Fo Guang Shan Hsi Lai Temple in Los Angeles, under Venerable Master Hsing Yun and are fully qualified in the Mahayana Tradition. Venerable Bao Shi mentioned that although we keep a low profile, we fully co-operated with other organisations when we are being approached.

To commemorate this occasion, donations were presented to the Singapore Buddhist Federation, the
